D1	<p><b>Everybody Needs To Breathe - an introduction to local exhaust ventilation</b></p> <p>If you are considering the use of local exhaust ventilation (LEV) or are currently using LEV then this film will be of interest to you. It shows the use of LEV in many work processes and the importance of effective design, use, maintenance and testing of LEV systems and describes some of the common problems that affect the performance of such systems.</p> <p>Run time: 14 minutes approx.</p>
D2A	<p><b>Vehicle Safety on Farms</b></p> <p>This compilation DVD consists of five films including 'Riding for a fall' and 'A ridge too far' which emphasise the need for training to ensure safe driving of ATVs and cover basic ATV safety procedures including how to load an ATV, towing trailers, stability and negotiating steep hillsides safely. 'Fatal traction' highlights the dangers and gives practical advice to agriculture and forestry workers on how to avoid them. 'Tractor action' uses realistic dramatisations to describe safe working practices for tractor operation. It is aimed at younger workers but is also of value to any users of tractors and tractor-operated machinery. 'Safe driving on slopes' informs and instructs people on the dangers and safe methods of driving farm vehicles and machinery on slopes.</p> <p>Run time: 86 minutes approx.</p>

D3A	<p><b>Signposts for Health and Safety</b></p> <p>This DVD consists of 10 x 30 minute films. A variety of small businesses show how they have successfully dealt with health and safety issues. Each episode also includes a health and safety surgery where an expert gives advice to a business owner on how to tackle a particular problem. The content has been updated as much as possible to reflect for example, recent changes to smoking in the workplace and noise exposure limits.</p> <p>Run time: 5 hours</p>

D4A	<p><b>Kidsafe</b></p> <p>A compilation of child-safety films. These films are ideal for teachers and pupils in first schools, parents, farmers and construction companies wishing to highlight specific dangers to youngsters when carrying out work near schools. 'Dangerous playground' features the dangers on farms for young children, 'Safe' highlights the dangers to young people on farms, 'Game Over' shows the risks of playing on construction sites and 'Worksmart' stories where children themselves describe the dangers associated with construction sites, farms, railways and climbing on roofs.</p> <p>Run time: 56 minutes approx.</p>

D5A	<p><b>NAPO in Risky Business</b></p> <p>This animated DVD follows the cartoon character NAPO in a series of sketches dealing with risk assessment in the workplace. It uses humour to help explain important risk messages to a workforce. It includes chapters on: Caution hazards; Assess the risk; Identify the unknown; Act on risks; Risky combination; Eliminate the risk; Safety pays. This DVD is likely to be most effective when it is used in a training environment.</p> <p>Run time: 9 minutes approx.</p>

D6A	<p><b>STEP - Slips and trips eLearning package</b></p> <p>STEP is an eLearning package providing slips and trips guidance through interactive learning. It is an easy way to learn about slips and trips, how they are caused, why preventing them is important and how to tackle them. STEP includes quizzes, videos, animations, case studies and interactive sequences. You should find it useful whatever your job role and place of work.</p>

D7A	<p><b>Health and Safety in the Woodworking Industry</b></p> <p>This DVD is aimed at managers and supervisors in the woodworking industry, but will also be useful for training operators, making them more aware of health and safety risks. In particular, it shows: the importance of a health and safety strategy for your business; that the majority of woodworking machinery accidents can be prevented by ensuring operators are properly trained and supervised; safe working practices, properly guarded machines and the use of safety devices; the hazards of noise and dust in the woodworking industry.</p> <p>Run time: 24 minutes</p>

D8A	<p><b>Dead Slow - Understanding the risks from slow moving vehicles</b></p> <p>In this DVD you will find re-enactments of three events where people have been hurt by slow moving vehicles at work. For each of the cases you will see the scenario played again, but this time how to do it safely. After watching the DVD talk through what you will have to do to control the risks from slow moving vehicles on your particular site.</p> <p>Run time: 8 minutes</p>

D9A	<p><b>How Are You Managing? - Dealing with the risk of asbestos in buildings</b></p> <p>Part one of this DVD provides a hard-hitting portrayal of the final days in the life of a building worker suffering from mesothelioma. It graphically demonstrates the potential outcome for those who are unknowingly being exposed to asbestos fibres in their day-to-day work. The key message is the importance of checking whether material contains asbestos before starting work. Part two shows how a dutyholder might address the requirements of the duty to manage asbestos in non-domestic premises from the perspective of a large and a small organisation.</p> <p>Run time: 27 minutes</p>
D9B	<p><b>How Are You Managing? - Dealing with the risk of asbestos in buildings</b></p> <p>See description above</p>
D10A	<p><b>Control of Legionella</b></p> <p>This DVD compilation is made up of three films. It contains an introductory film, and two films previously not available to the public which are used for the training of HSE and Local Authority inspectors. The first looks at the two main risk systems in turn and explains how the risks from exposure should be managed and controlled. The second, on cooling tower systems, describes the microbiological risks associated, how they can be minimized, plus advice on inspections. The third, on hot and cold water systems, describes how legionella bacteria grow in these systems, how hot and cold services are engineered, and how good design can help to control legionella.</p> <p>Run time: 66 minutes approx.</p>

D11A	<p><b>Bring a Smile to Safety Training - featuring NAPO</b></p> <p>This DVD uses humour to get serious messages across. A series of short animated films feature the character NAPO coming to terms with health and safety in the workplace. The films should appeal to all workers especially those who are young or inexperienced and will help them to understand hazards and how to avoid them. The sketches cross language barriers because there are no speaking parts. The stories show how accidents could have been avoided.</p> <p>Run time: 58 minutes approx.</p>
D11B	<p><b>Bring a Smile to Safety Training - featuring NAPO</b></p> <p>See description above</p>
D12A	<p><b>Safe Start - featuring NAPO</b></p> <p>This animated DVD follows the hapless NAPO as he starts a new job. This film is ideal for training new and inexperienced workers and also cuts across language barriers, as there are no speaking parts. It takes a light-hearted approach, but there are serious messages including: the importance of proper health and safety training and instruction; urging workers not to hesitate to ask questions; the need to pay attention to safety messages, such as fire drills, and location of escape routes; and watching out for others – not putting co-workers at risk.</p> <p>Run time: 10 minutes approx.</p>

<b>D13A</b>	<p><b>Lighten the Load - featuring NAPO</b></p> <p>This DVD shows how to avoid musculoskeletal problems in the workplace. These serious messages are presented in a light-hearted manner and are ideal for training people, especially those who don't speak English well. Sections deal with: fast-paced work and repetitive activity; moving and carrying heavy loads to prevent strain and injury; workstation height and layout; excessive and continual twisting; use of lifting aids to eliminate or improve manual handling; how to ensure good grip when handling tools; vibration and use of power tools.</p> <p>Run time: 10 minutes approx.</p>

<b>D14</b>	<p><b>Watch Your Step - a toolbox talk for construction</b></p> <p>Thousands of construction workers are injured each year after a trip or a slip. This DVD gives practical advice on how to avoid these sorts of accidents happening to you. It features case studies including an injured worker's story and a site manager explaining how his firm have tackled the problem.</p>

<b>D16A</b>	<p><b>The Heat Within: The effect of fire in pressurised tunnels</b></p> <p>A fire in the confined space of a tunnel can have serious consequences for those working in it, as well as anyone who tries to rescue them. This film shows how compressed air and an added oxygen content will act on various materials commonly found in tunnels, and the dramatic effect of how a tunnel fire will burn. It emphasises how important it is to prevent fires starting, to wear correct Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and to maintain good standards of housekeeping and site safety practice.</p>

This DVD is simply and graphically illustrated using wordless communication - especially useful for overcoming language barriers. The message given throughout is clear- be aware of the substances that can harm your skin and take simple precautions to protect yourself.</p>

<b>D18A</b>	<b>NAPO in Safe Maintenance</b>  NAPO and his workmates show us how not to do safe maintenance in a series of episodes relating to machinery and building maintenance. As usual, there is a serious message behind the various cartoon mishaps, whether it is to lock off machinery before working on it, to avoid rushing jobs, or to take care on all jobs no matter what they are - even on what may seem like routine repairs. NAPO shows us the potential consequences of getting health and safety disastrously wrong (even managing to survive inhaling poisonous fumes in confined spaces and igniting flammable substances). This DVD uses wordless communication - particularly useful for workers who do not have English as their first language.

<b>D19A</b>	<b>Getting to Grips with Stress at Work</b>  Work-related stress is a big problem in the UK and can lead to higher absence levels, increased staff turnover and human error. But there are things employers and employees can do to tackle the causes and reduce the levels of stress at work. This DVD includes a number of personal case studies (with actors in the roles of workers and management) which are based on real stories. Additionally, there are stories which show how employers have dealt with work-related stress in their organisation. This product incorporates subtitles and a British Sign Language option.
