



HSENI PROPOSALS IN RELATION TO TWO HEALTH AND SAFETY APPROVED CODES OF PRACTICE (ACOPS) - "UNLOADING PETROL FROM ROAD TANKERS" AND "THE COMPILATION OF SAFETY DATA SHEETS" – ANALYSIS AND SUMMARY OF CONSULTATION RESPONSES AND HSENI COMMENTS

1. This is a summary report of the outcome of the HSENI’s formal, statutory consultation on proposals to approve for use in Northern Ireland an updated ACOP on “Unloading Petrol from Road Tankers” published by the Health and Safety Executive in Great Britain and to withdraw approval for the ACOP in relation to “The Compilation of Safety Data Sheets” which is now obsolete.

2. The consultation document was published on the HSENI website and ran from 4 February 2015 to 29 April 2015. Letters were issued to approximately 600 consultees inviting comments on the proposals, costs relevant to Northern Ireland and the conclusion that the proposals would have no adverse effect on section 75 groups. The details of the four responses received are set out in the table below:
