ARE YOU FITTING THE FOLLOWING TYPES OF APPLIANCES?

- Wood and multi-fuel burning stove
- Central heating boiler
- Open fire
- Gas cooker
- Oil/solid fuel cooker
- Flues for gas or solid fuel

YOU ARE AT RISK IF YOUR APPLIANCE IS:

- Not properly installed
- Not working properly
- Not checked regularly or maintained
- Not provided with enough fresh air
- Not burning the recommended fuel and you have no CO alarm fitted

HOW TO STAY SAFE

- Refer to appliances instruction manual to ensure appliance is installed, used and maintained in a safe condition.
- Have your installation independently checked www.buildingcontrol-ni.com
- Your appliance should be installed by a competent person.
- Provide ventilation within the room where the appliance is fitted to prevent build-up of CO
- Use the fuel as recommended by manufacturer
- Maintain your appliance and its flues at least yearly, more often depending on the manufacturers instruction manual
- Sweep your chimney at least yearly
- Buy a CO alarm (BSEN 50291) and follow the instructions on set-up, testing and replacing the alarm. Ensure the battery is replaced regularly
